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1 Explanation

1.1 Use this form for the revalidation of the SEP (land), SEP (sea), TMG, MLA or EIR(A) ratings on the basis of a refresher training.

1.2 To be eligible for the revalidation of the rating you need to have obtained the set amount of experience in the 12 months prior to the expiry date.

1.3 The process time of your application will take approximately 15 working days from the moment your application has been submitted completely, correctly and paid in full.

1.4 If your licence document is not revalidated by your examiner, you will need to submit copies of your logbook as proof of the experience. In this case a fee has to be paid to process the revalidation. Fill out paragraph 14.

1.5 Incomplete or incorrectly completed forms (including not submitting the required documents) will not be processed.
